

When I Don't Know What To Do, I Get Back To The Basics:

- “Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.” (Colossians 3:2)
- “Put on bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; Forbearing one another, forgiving one another.” (Colossians 3:12&13)
- “Above ALL: put on charity (love), which is the bond of perfectness.” (Colossians 3:14)
- “Let the peace of God rule in your heart.” (Colossians 3:15)
- “Let the Word of God dwell in you richly”! (Colossians 3:16)
- “Whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do ALL in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by Him. Whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.” (Colossians 3:17; 23&24)
- “Continue in prayer”! (Colossians 4:2); “Pray without ceasing”! (I Thessalonians 5:17)
- “Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.” (Colossians 4:5)
- “Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.” (Colossians 4:6); Remember: God has trusted us with His gospel, “so we speak; NOT AS PLEASING MEN, BUT GOD, which trieth our hearts.” (I Thessalonians 2:4)
- Remember: The will of God is “that ye should abstain from fornication.” (I Thessalonians 4:3)
- Remember: “In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.” (I Thessalonians 5:18)
- “Edify one another,” (I Thessalonians 5:11)
- “Warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward ALL”! (I Thessalonians 5:14)
- “Abstain from ALL appearance of evil”! (I Thessalonians 5:22)
- “Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.” (Philippians 2:3)
- Remember you have given your life wholly and completely to Him. “For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure.” (Philippians 2:13)
- “Be careful (anxious) for NOTHING; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.” (Philippians 4:6)
- “THINK ON THINGS THAT ARE TRUE, HONEST, JUST, PURE, LOVELY, OF GOOD REPORT, VIRTUOUS, PRAISEWORTHY.” (Philippians 4:8)
- Remember: “You can do ALL things through Christ who strengthens you”!! (Philippians 4:13); “SO STAND FAST IN THE LORD”!! (Philippians 4:1); “Casting ALL your burdens on Him, He shall sustain thee.” (Psalms 55:22)
- Remember, “God is able to do exceeding abundantly above ALL that I ask or think, according to the power that worketh in me, unto Him be the glory... forever and ever. Amen. (Ephesians 3:20&21 personalized).
